Kill Burrowing Rodents at a Distance

To eliminate burrowing rodents and their tunnels, the Rodenator Remote R2 Pest Elimination System now includes remote wireless detonation with 20% more concussive power

For those tired of burrowing rodents destroying their property, the new Rodenator Remote R2 Pest Elimination System by Meyer Industries adds wireless detonation up to 200 feet from the source, and 20% more power to the industry-leading Rodenator line.

The Rodenator Remote R2 system, like the industry-leading Rodenator Pro System it's based on, can deliver a precision underground shockwave to the targeted animals' tunnels and dens -- eliminating the rodents and collapsing their tunnel systems to prevent re-infestation -- without the use of chemicals, poisons, or time-consuming baiting and trapping. However, the new R2 version provides remote, hands-free detonation at a distance up to 200 feet, placing the operator well away from the blast zone.

Although the Rodenator Pro is currently being used by thousands of satisfied customers around the globe, many users will feel more comfortable operating the R2 at a distance from the blast noise and concussion. The R2 system also creates less user fatigue, allowing for more pest control treatments per hour.

For added safety, lighted controls on the back of the unit show its stage of use; and quick connection fuel hoses and internal rechargeable lithium batteries add to its ease of use.

With the R2, once a user finds a tunnel opening, typical treatment time is about one per minute.

With more concussive power, the R2 is even more effective against open tunnel system animals such as rabbits, ground squirrels, prairie dogs, ground hogs, badgers, armadillos, fox and coyote as well as gophers, moles, voles, woodchucks and rats.

To watch the explosive events, the Rodenator R2 is already available on YouTube.

Manufactured by Midvale, Idaho-based Meyer Industries, the Rodenator Remote R2 system injects a calibrated mix of propane and oxygen into the targeted rodent's burrow by wireless remote control. Since propane is heavier than air, the gaseous mix sinks to the lowest parts of the burrow where the nest usually is. When the operator remotely activates this mixture of blended gases, the oxygen mixture rapidly expands at 5,000 feet per second, creating a high-pressure shockwave that kills the rodent and collapses the tunnel systems of many burrowing species.

Because the system detonates the mixture of propane and oxygen immediately, it leaves no chemical residue and is suitable for organic pest control. Since the resulting concussion will often collapse the tunnel system and bury the pest, users don't handle the carcass and new rodents won't re-inhabit the collapsed tunnels.

The Rodenator Remote R2 Pest Elimination System includes the R2 unit, remote control, wireless transmitter, accessory box, training video, gopher shovel and instruction manual. The unit has a limited lifetime warranty.
